Music Plus



Music Plus is an exciting program at Centenary State High School which caters to students in Years 7 – 9 with advanced musical abilities. This program has been created for the needs of students who demonstrate a very high level of capacity in the area of music and/or instrumental music. The course is designed to allow instrumentalists and vocalists to explore and extend their musical capabilities in the early years of high school.

Students are taught by specialist music teachers, studying units of work that align to the Australian Curriculum but that differ from those that students in regular Years 7 – 9 Arts subjects study. They are extended on the respective year level (band level) coursework and will engage in more cognitively demanding concepts related to the three strands of music: musicology, composing and performing.

This pathway is intended for students who wish to combine their study of Music and Instrumental Music, and links directly with Years 11 and 12 General subjects Music and Music Extension.

Students in Music Plus are also provided with the opportunity to gain national certification from the Australian Music Examinations Board in Theory of Music. Composition students are catered for with an Artist in Residence program (in 2022 provided by Topology).

There are many other opportunities with external providers and agencies provided to students in Music Plus, including but not limited to: SHEP at the Queensland Conservatorium of Music, Creative Generation (State Schools on Stage and MOST), composition competitions such as Vermillion High and Triple J Unearthed, and performances events such as RockFest. Students are also able to engage with real-world opportunities to see live musicians and performances as appropriate.

Entry to this subject is via an audition. Please note this program is subject to availability of vacancies. To apply for a place in the program, please complete the application form (over) and return it by Monday June 20th, 2022.

You will be contacted before the end of Term 3 to arrange an audition via your email address. Please ensure you check your junk email. Auditions will be held in Term 4, with dates and times to be communicated to those who have nominated.
